Overview

The Master in *International Translation* is a 1-year programme offering students professional training focusing on the specific skills and knowledge they will need to work as translators for international institutions. The working languages are English, French, German, Italian, and Spanish. Differently from any other master offered in Italy, this course covers all the genres and topics international translators are likely to face throughout their career: in disciplines such as Economics, Law, Politics and Sociology, as well as all kinds of Technical-Scientific texts. The master trains students to work with state-of-the-art technology (terminological databases, CAT tools, workflow management). The hands-on training labs and the internship opportunities will guarantee the amount of experience needed to be ready for the world of work. Students are also specifically trained to pass the admission tests required to work for some international institutions such as the European Union.

Requirements

Students who hold a degree awarded by an Italian university:

Other students: Degrees from non-Italian universities will have to be recognized as valid by the commission, according to current international agreements.

For all:

Proficient knowledge of English, French and Italian is required. The ideal candidate will be a native speaker of one of these languages. Intermediate knowledge of either German or Spanish is also required. Language skills will be evaluated

Fees

Tuition fees are € 5000 to be paid in two instalments, the first (€ 3552) when the student enrolls, and the second (€ 1448) by 4 September 2017.

Non-EU citizens are reminded they need to cover their health insurance costs and visa expenses.
