

Clarifications on the Assessment Criteria for the Course Unit of the “Paradigms of National and International Order”

1. For Students Enrolled in “European Legal Studies”

a) Two presentations and 6 reaction papers of your choice;

or

b) One presentation, a research paper, and 6 reaction papers of your choice.

2. For Students Enrolled in “Global Law” Who Wants to Have 7.5 Credits for the Course Unit (4.5 Credits for Module II of Principles of Constitutional Law and 3 Credits for “Other Activities”)

a) Two presentations and 7 reaction papers of your choice;

or

b) One presentation, a research paper, and 7 reaction papers of your choice;

or

b) Three presentations.

3. For Students Enrolled in “Global Law” Who Wants to Have 4.5 Credits for the Course Unit (4.5 Credits for Module II of Principles of Constitutional Law)

a) Two presentations and 3 reaction papers of your choice;

or

b) One presentation, a research paper, and 3 reaction papers of your choice.

4. For Students Enrolled in “Global Law” Who Wants to Have 3 Credits for the Course Unit (3 Credits for “Other Activities”)

a) Two presentations and 1 reaction paper of your choice;

or

b) One presentation, a research paper, and 1 reaction paper of your choice.
