

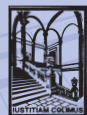

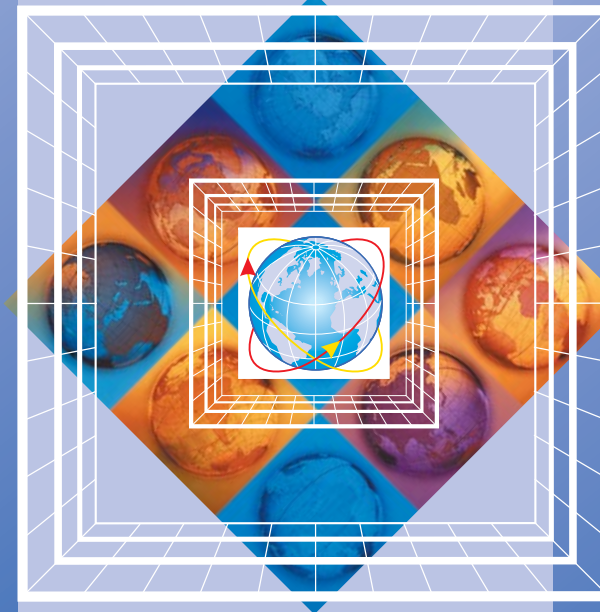

International Trade Law Post Graduate Course

Current trends in international trade relations have brought about an ever-increasing number and variety of international business transactions all over the world.

This course offers an important challenge and aims at providing candidates with a common legal approach to the main legal issues in international trade law and contract drafting.

Some key issues:

- policies and the legal framework of international trade organisations;
- legal issues in international trade among groups of countries with different levels of economic development and social patterns;
- harmonisation of laws at international and regional level (including the framework of UNCITRAL, WTO and UNIDROIT);
- sources of law in international trade;
- legal aspects of international contract negotiation (formation of contracts, pre-contractual agreements and confidentiality agreements, letters of intent, e-commerce);
- main types of contracts in international trade: sale of goods, technology licence agreements, joint ventures, mergers and acquisitions, financing agencies, intellectual property rights, trade marks and patents, project financing, agency and distribution, state contracts, construction and engineering contracts etc.;
- the legal constraints to commercial strategies and antitrust regulations with particular reference to the European Union framework;
- modes of payment and international investment guarantees;
- arbitration and dispute resolution.

The course adopts a flexible training approach. Active teaching methods are based on lectures, performance-oriented exercises, case studies, role plays and interaction among lecturers, tutor and participants.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Requirements and Language

Graduates in law, business or economics and undergraduates in their last year at University (provided they are on schedule with their exams) may apply. **Since the Course is in English, a good working knowledge of the English language is essential.**

Application and Attendance

Candidates should fill in the application form they may obtain from the Secretariat, or download from the web site <http://tradelaw.iuse.it>. Should this not be possible, they may submit an application indicating their data and academic qualification. Copy of supporting documents (including transcript of academic record and certificate of English knowledge) should accompany the application. This documentation will not be returned. Full-time attendance is required throughout the programme.

Scholarships

A few scholarships are available for foreign students or Italians not from Turin to cover part of board and lodging expenses. Such scholarships are awarded upon written request in the application and on the basis of candidates' documentation.

Selection

Selection will take place on the basis of the documentation received. Each candidate will be notified about the results of the selection by the Secretariat.

Preferably, candidates should mention in their application an e-mail address or a fax number where they can be reached.

Credits

Training credits (crediti formativi) will be granted by the Turin Bar Association (Ordine degli Avvocati di Torino) to its members attending the course.

Registration fees

Registration fees are 2500,00€.

Requests should be returned by mail to the Secretariat by **18 January 2010** at the latest.
